Result code: 0 = not OK, defects found; 1 = OK; 2 = not tested, no result; 3 = system error

Replies to all other commands remain unchanged.

The communication protocol can be selected in the "Command Decoder" settings in System Configuration window.

"Handshake Standard" is the new protocol, "Basic Standard" the established one.
